

## **IB / AP Testing Processes & Procedures**

### **IB Juniors - AP Juniors - AP Sophomores – AP Freshman**

The expectation is that all underclassmen testing AP and IB exams will be marked PSR (School related Absence) on the date of testing, but will be in class the remainder of days until June 15<sup>th</sup>. After the exam, the relevant and rigorous curriculum should continue, culminating in an end of course exam or project for a grade.

### **AP Seniors – Must follow the above listed guidelines.**

**IB Seniors** – Are required to be in school each day including April 29<sup>th</sup>. The rigors of the IB testing schedule in the month of May are stressful, and we understand that each student must prepare differently. It is our preference that IB seniors use this time to prepare for exams and use the resources available at school. Beginning May 3<sup>rd</sup> we will open study halls each day for all four periods. IB Seniors may sign in and out as necessary. The testing schedule and schedule of study halls are attached.

- IB seniors enrolled in any non-IB course must meet all requirements of that course. This includes attendance until June 3<sup>rd</sup> and finals.
- IB seniors will be issued passes that must be presented at the gate to enter and or leave campus.

**While on campus all school policies, including dress code, must be followed.**
